Overview

Lingua Francas is a web app that can be used in any browser. The purpose is to facilitate language exchange by providing a forum to find native speakers of a language you want to learn.

Technologies



Features

Each user will have a profile page that lists the languages they are native in and the ones they are learning. They will also receive notifications, and make public posts from here.

Private Messages

Profile Page

Users can send messages to each other. A user will invite another user to chat from their profile. The second user must accept the invitation for the conversation to begin.

Group Messages Users can invite other users to a group to chat with multiple people at once.

Public Posts

Users can create a post in various languages that display to everyone on the message board page.
Users can also like/dislike a post or leave a comment on the post.

Search for Language Partners

Users can be found by searching for their username or by a language they are fluent in (as stated on their profile page).


Translation

Users can translate the text on the message board page or in a conversation (private/group messages) into various languages.


Testing
