Engineering Red Team

Purpose

A number of your colleagues with experience in getting grants from and reviewing proposals for a number of federal and state agencies have agreed to serve as internal proposal reviewers. The goal is for your proposal to be evaluated before it is submitted, allowing you to hear how reviewers *may* evaluate it. Clearly the comments will be just the opinion of the Red Team members, and it is up to the PIs to decide whether to follow them or not.

The expectation though is that, given the experience of the Red Team members, their comments will lead to a better proposal increasing the chances of success.

Process

PIs should submit to the AD for Research and Graduate Studies:

- link to the RFP or the actual RFP text,
- completed proposal (including budget),
- and deadline by which they would like to receive comments.

PI bios and C&P are optional.

The AD will ask the members of the Red Team if any of them are available to provide feedback by the deadline. If not, the proposal team will be notified.
